A&A Tools USAID Procurement Teams are trying - Example

Broad Agency Announcement (BAA)

BAA:

- Used for research and development (defined in <u>FAR Part 35</u>)
- Not, in itself, a procurement instrument, but a method to communicate to the market a general interest regarding a development problem

A Method to Collaborate:

- Co-create and co-design a development solution based only on an initial idea
- Is defined as a competitive process under <u>FAR Section 6.102</u>
- Can engage with any type of organization: Public, private, government, non-government, for-profit, non-profit, etc.
- Can result in a contract, grant, cooperative agreement, GDA, IAA, G2G, MOU, etc.

A Fixed Focus on the Development Problem/Design-to-Solution:

- Not Design-to-Budget, no budget allocated
- Not Design-to-Instrument, instrument type not determined in advance

Partner Perspective on USAID's attempts with A&A tools

Our Perspective and Experience

- A&A instruments are a *means* to achieving development outcomes and results
- Choose instrument based on *what USAID wants to achieve*, and then work to reduce cycle time/PALT
- We value creativity and innovation in solicitations but not at the expense of clarity, efficiency and effectiveness
- A&A innovations should support an efficient and compliant award process AND facilitate efficient, effective, and responsive implementation
- Very valuable: Draft SOWs, pre-proposal conferences, oral presentations

Our Recommendations

- Engage regularly and often with USAID partners
- For A&A innovations that have worked well, disseminate best practices and train Missions to use them effectively and efficiently
- Quality control is paramount!
