Assessment for Learning (A4L)

- An international platform to support learning assessment, which would:
 - ✓ Develop and strengthen national learning assessment systems.
 - ✓ Increase the availability of learning data at country, regional and global levels, and promote knowledge sharing.
 - ✓ Improve the use of learning data to inform educational policies and teacher training
 - ✓ Develop new assessment tools to measure learning beyond reading and numeracy.
